## 3) Topics

Passenger traffic results were steady on both domestic and international routes, particularly for flights bound for Kyushu as well as the Sendai route and flights bound for South Korea and the Shanghai route respectively, with seats mostly sold out throughout the period.

Peak days for both domestic and international routes were on May 3 for outbound and May 7 for inbound flights.

Peach began its services in March 2012 with Kansai Airport as its hub. It established Naha Airport as a secondary hub in July 2014 and began servicing Haneda Airport in August 2015. Peach currently flies 18 aircraft on 12 domestic and 13 international routes, operating more than 90 flights daily and serving more than 13,000 passengers each day. Peach is also scheduled to start servicing Sendai Airport and Shin-Chitose Airport as hub airports in FY2017 and FY2018 respectively.
