

New Osaka (Kansai) – Tokyo (Narita) Route to Open

- **Flight services scheduled to begin on October 27, 2013 (Sun)***
- **Services to start with two round-trip flights daily (4 flights)**
- **Full-fledged hiring of cockpit and maintenance crews underway in the Kanto region**

Peach Aviation Limited (Peach; Representative Director & CEO: Shinichi Inoue, Head office: Izumisano-shi, Osaka) announced today that it is opening an Osaka (Kansai) – Tokyo (Narita) route and that it has filed an application for approval with the Ministry of Land, Infrastructure, Transport and Tourism for the operation of flights using congested airports.

The Osaka (Kansai) – Tokyo (Narita) route is scheduled to be opened on October 27 (Sun), with two round-trip flights daily (four flights) *.

To mark the occasion, Peach flight attendants, cockpit and maintenance crews, and CEO Shinichi Inoue, paid a visit today to Zojoji temple in Minato Ward, Tokyo, to offer prayers for “safety in the skies,” as they renewed their pledge for safe flight operations.

Peach CEO Shinichi Inoue commented, “I am extremely pleased that after starting services in March 2012, Peach is now opening a route going to and from the capital. The open of this route came as a result of a very large number of requests that we had received from our customers to fly to the capital. We are grateful for the support that we have been receiving from our many customers, and at the same time, we renew our pledge to offer safe flights, as we feel a keen sense of responsibility.”

“For Peach’s further business development, it is indispensable that we have excellent cockpit and maintenance crews, the people who support our safe operations each day. We hope that our team will be joined by people who share our desire to create innovation in aviation,” he added.

As part of activities to hire cockpit crews, Peach will hold company information sessions through July, starting with a session in Narita City on June 16 (Sun) and in Tokyo on June 17 (Mon).
