Due to a serious incident on MM252, Peach cancelled 2 flights on both Osaka (Kansai) – Sapporo (Shin-Chitose) and Osaka (Kansai) – Tokyo (Narita) routes on April 29. The flights were cancelled due aircraft inspection.
