Passenger Enplanements during the Year End and New Year Holidays 2014/15

Peach Aviation Limited (Peach; Representative Director & CEO: Shinichi Inoue, Head office: Izumisano-shi, Osaka) announces today the passenger boarding results for Peach flights operated during the 2014/15 year-end/New Year holiday travel period (December 19–January 4).

(2) Review

An exceptionally high number of passengers flew Peach on both Domestic and International flights during the year-end holiday travel period.

Total passengers carried strongly exceeded the figure for the same period in 2013/2014 on both Domestic and International flights. In addition, the Domestic seat load factor was comparable with the figure for the 2013/14 holiday travel period while the International seat load factor increased 3.1 percentage points over the previous year. This increase was due to the strong demand for flights from overseas destinations supported by the weaker Japanese Yen. Particularly popular were flights to and from South Korea and Hong Kong, with many of these operated with all or most seats occupied.

Note:

Domestic routes/flights are those departing AND arriving within Japan International routes/flights are those with at least one segment outside of Japan.
