



## **Peach Starts Service on Okinawa (Naha) – Seoul (Incheon) Route, Increases Number of Flights on Okinawa (Naha) – Fukuoka Route Routes from Okinawa Expanded Further Enhancing Hub Functionality**

**OSAKA & TOKYO 4 Sep, 2015**-Starting from today Peach Aviation Limited (Peach; Representative Director & CEO: Shinichi Inoue) started service on its Okinawa (Naha) – Seoul (Incheon) route, increasing the number of routes arriving and departing at Naha Airport, and also added a flight to its Okinawa (Naha) – Fukuoka route.

The Okinawa (Naha) – Seoul (Incheon) route will be served by seven flights a week (one round-trip flight daily), while an additional round-trip flight has been added to the Okinawa (Naha) – Fukuoka route, increasing the number of daily round-trip flights that we operate to two.

Peach Representative Director & CEO Shinichi Inoue provided the following comment on the opening of this route: "The Seoul route is now the third international route arriving and departing at Naha Airport. With the start of service for this route, I am confident that we will be able to attract the robust demand for tourism to Japan and further increase the number of tourists visiting Okinawa. Starting today we also increased the number of flights on our Okinawa (Naha) – Fukuoka route, which continues to be popular since it started service in July of last year. Peach has enhanced Naha Airport's functionality as one of its hubs through the expansion of its route network, as well as by increasing the number of aircraft parked overnight at the airport to two. We will continue to work to expand our routes to the countries of Asia from Naha Airport, and we hope that we can contribute in our own small way to Okinawa meeting its goal of ten million tourists visiting the area by 2021."

Peach will continue to aggressively develop new routes and tap new demand for commercial air service. We will work to start a new movement based on the motto: "Peach flies and changes lifestyles. Peach flies and changes regions." and contribute to the invigoration of the regions we service.
