

Peach Set to Open Okinawa (Naha)/Narita Route and Increase Number of Flights between Okinawa (Naha) and Taipei (Taoyuan)

Expanding network of routes from Okinawa and further boosting hub functions

Osaka 8 Dec, 2015 - Peach Aviation Limited ("Peach", Representative Director and CEO: Shinichi Inoue) announced today that it will open a new route between Okinawa (Naha) and Narita and increase its number of flights between Okinawa (Naha) and Taipei (Taoyuan).

Starting on February 20 (Sat), Peach will offer one round-trip flight between Okinawa (Naha) and Narita three days a week (Monday, Thursday, and Saturday) and increase its current seven round-trip flights a week between Okinawa (Naha) and Taipei (Taoyuan) to two round-trip flights on Wednesday, Friday, and Sunday for a total of 10 round-trips weekly.

Representative Director and CEO Shinichi Inoue said about the opening of the new route and the increased number of flights:

"I am very pleased that after hearing many comments wishing that we would open a route between Okinawa (Naha) and Tokyo (Narita), we are able to do so at this time. With the servicing of our Narita route, we will now be offering a total of six routes departing from and arriving at Naha Airport; three domestic routes including the Narita route, and three international routes including the Okinawa – Seoul (Incheon) route that was opened in September. The start of services on our Narita route will make it easier for people who live in the capital to visit Okinawa and to cotinue their travels on our international routes from Okinawa to other Asian destinations to further enhance our hub functions at Naha Airport. We would like to continue to boost our hub features at Naha Airport, blend into the region as "a part of the community", and make efforts to revitalize Okinawa as we move forward toward the objective set by Okinawa Prefecture to bring in 10 million tourists by fiscal 2021."

Peach will continue to aggressively expand its routes and generate further aviation demand while promoting a new movement that "fllying Peach can change lifestyle, and flying Peach can change regions" to contribute to the revitalization of its destination areas.
