

Announcing Establishment of Okinawa-Based CAs Ahead of Full-Fledged Operations at Peach's Okinawa Hub With auditions to be held for CAs

- Recruitment to get underway for Okinawa-based CAs in addition to Kansai Airport-based CAs
- Company briefings to be held in South Korea and Taiwan
- Anticipated number of hires to be around 50, to join the company in October 2016 or thereafter
- Entries accepted until the May 12 deadline

Osaka 30 March 30, 2016 - Peach Aviation Limited ("Peach"; Representative Director and CEO: Shinichi Inoue) announced today that it would assign cabin attendants to be based in Okinawa ahead of the start of full-fledged operations at its Naha hub and began accepting entries for an "audition for cabin attendants".

Peach is planning to assign cabin attendants based in Okinawa from autumn 2016 ahead of the commecement of full-fledged operations at the Okinawa hub in a move that will lead to the opening of new routes flying to and from Naha Airport. As a secondary hub after Kansai Airport as of September 2013, Peach currently operates a total of six routes out of Naha: three domestic (Narita, Kansai, and Fukuoka) and three international (Seoul, Taipei, Hong Kong).

The company is planning to accept 50 new hires, who are scheduled to join the company in October 2016 or thereafter. It will make a call for cabin attendants to be based at Naha Airport (Okinawa) in line with its cabin attendant staff based at Kansai Airport.

In the same manner as cabin attendants based at Kansai Airport, those who become based at Naha Airport (Okinawa) will receive training and work for a designated period in Tokyo and at Kansai Airport upon joining the company, then relocate to Okinawa and fly chiefly on routes departing from and arriving at Naha Airport as part of Peach's bid to improve the efficiency of its flight operations and aim to boost the economy of Okinawa and create local jobs.

As with the previous audition, Peach will hold company briefings and preliminary screening in South Korea and Taiwan.
