

Osaka (Kansai) – Amami Route Launches December 26th

Second route serving the Amami Islands following the launch of the Tokyo (Narita) – Amami route on October 1st

- **Osaka (Kansai) – Amami route to start on December 26th (Thursday) (One return flight per day)**
- **Ticket sales start on August 26th (Monday) 17:00, from ¥4,790 one way**

Osaka, 21 August, 2019 - Peach Aviation Limited (“Peach”; Representative Director and CEO: Shinichi Inoue) today announced the launch of its Osaka (Kansai) – Amami route.

The Osaka (Kansai) – Amami route will launch with one return flight per day from December 26th (Thursday). This becomes our second route to serve the Amami Islands following the introduction of the Tokyo (Narita) – Amami route from October 1st (Tuesday).

Shinichi Inoue, Representative Director and CEO of Peach, commented, “Amami has more than enough to attract international tourists. Peach is to launch routes to the islands from both Tokyo (Narita) and Osaka (Kansai), thus enabling the kind of casual travel only afforded by an LCC, and therefore expects to further rejuvenate and develop the area.”

Peach is constantly striving to further enrich and expand its network with the goal of being a “bridge with Asia,” and to boost various destinations together with its local inhabitants.

Peach will complete its integration with Narita-based airline Vanilla Air by the end of the 2019 fiscal year, aiming to become Asia’s leading LCC.
