■About the Philharmonic Orchestra of the Filarmonica del Teatro Comunale di Modena

An orchestra based in Modena, Italy, established in May 2022 under an agreement with the Filarmonica del Teatro Comunale di Modena, named after the great tenor Luciano Pavarotti, who was from Modena. The role of music director is held by Japanese conductor Hirofumi Yoshida. Since its founding, it has held numerous large-scale concerts featuring world-renowned artists such as Henrik Nánási, Joel Sanderson, and Dmitry Masleev. In addition, the orchestra is active on the international stage, having performed in Abu Dhabi and in Japan at Horyu-ji Temple in Nara (a UNESCO World Heritage Site). They have also showcased their music at the Ferrari Grand Gala held in Modena, the hometown of the renowned automaker Ferrari, demonstrating their wide-ranging engagements.

■Conductor Profile

Hirofumi Yoshida

Hirofumi Yoshida has conducted performances at opera houses in cities including Rome, Bologna, Trieste, Palermo, Cagliari, Messina, Mantua, Novara, Bergamo, Lucca, Chieti, Sassari, as well as in Cairo, Latvia, Ljubljana, and Cluj-Napoca. He has also frequently collaborated with orchestras from the Teatro San Carlo in Naples, Teatro Carlo Felice of Genoa, the Teatro Lirico di Cagliari, and the Orchestre des Concerts Lamoureux of Paris. Yoshida has conducted numerous Italian

operas such as Puccini's "Tosca," "La Bohème," "La Rondine," and "Madama Butterfly," as well as Verdi's "La Traviata," "Aida," "Rigoletto," and "Don Carlo." In Japan, he led the Filarmonica del Teatro Comunale di Bologna at the Japan Opera Festival organized by the Sawakami Opera Foundation, successfully producing outdoor operas of international standard at Kiyomizu-dera Temple (2013), Nijo Castle (2014), Himeji Castle and Kyoto National Museum (2015), the Daigokuden Hall of Heijo Palace in Nara (2016), Nagoya Castle (2018, 2019), and Horyu-ji Temple (2023). He currently serves as Music Director of the Philharmonic Orchestra of the Filarmonica del Teatro Comunale di Modena and Principal Guest Conductor of the Odesa National Academic Opera and Ballet Theater in Ukraine. In 2024, he was selected for the Minister of Education, Culture, Sports, Science and Technology Award in recognition of his contributions to the promotion of opera, international exchange through music, and the advancement of Japan's arts and culture.
