

Additional Winter 2020 Sales Starting!

- **Routes on sale: All domestic and some international routes**
- **Applicable boarding period: Domestic routes Feb.1, Monday - March, 27, 2021, Saturday**
- **International routes Dec. 24, 2020 (Thu.) - March 27, 2021 (Sat.)**
- **Sales start date: Oct. 26, 2020 (Mon.) 04:00 p.m.**

Osaka, Oct. 26, 2020 - Peach Aviation Limited (“Peach”, Representative Director and CEO: Takeaki Mori) will start additional sales on all 28 domestic routes and three international routes for the 2020 winter schedule.

For domestic flights, from Feb. 1 to March 27 2021, we will sell tickets for 28 routes including the Nagoya (Chubu) to Sapporo (Shin-Chitose) and Sendai Route, which entered service on Dec. 24 as Peach’s first route to and from Chubu Airport.

In addition, international flights will go on sale from Dec. 24 to March 27 for the three routes, Osaka (Kansai)/ Tokyo (Haneda) / Tokyo (Narita) to Taipei (Taoyuan), which resumed operations on Oct. 25 for the first time in about seven months.

Routes that will go on sale are shown in the table below. Tickets can be purchased via the Peach website (flypeach.com/en) and at the Contact Center.

Peach had reduced and suspended flights on certain routes due to the spread of COVID-19, but it resumed operations of all domestic routes on June 19 and on some international routes on Oct. 25. Peach will provide safe and reliable travel in the skies under the theme of “Bridging your sky”, connecting various regions, while continuing to take thorough measures to prevent infection.

About Peach (www.flypeach.com/en)

Peach began operating out of Kansai Airport in March 2012. Peach currently services 26 domestic and 17 international routes with 32 aircraft from its hubs: New-Chitose Airport, Sendai Airport, Narita Airport, Fukuoka Airport and Naha Airport in addition to Kansai Airport. From Dec. 24, Peach will start operating new routes from Chubu Airport, Sapporo(New-Chitose)/Sendai-Nagoya(Chubu) and make Chubu Airport its new hub. From Oct.25, Peach will restart international flights connecting Osaka(Kansai)/Tokyo(Narita)/Tokyo(Haneda)-Taipei(Tauyuan). Aiming to become the leading LCC in Asia, we are expanding our route network from various regions, mainly in the Tokyo metropolitan area and Kansai. Also, we moved our boarding terminal at Narita Airport from Terminal 3 to Terminal 1 .Boarding procedures are made at check-in counter on the first floor of the South Wing for domestic flights and the B counter on the fourth floor of the North Wing for international flights. When flying Peach for international flights at Kansai Airport, boarding procedures are made at the Terminal 2, and passengers are arrived at Terminal 1.
