Get a head start on your new year's travel with Peach! 2023 Summer Schedule Tickets on Sale Now - 8 domestic routes will go on sale early to support travel demand -

- **Applicable routes: 8 domestic routes**
- **Applicable boarding period: March 26 to October 28, 2023**
- **Sales start date: November 7, 2022 at 4:00 p.m.**

Osaka 7 November, 2022 - Today, November 7, Peach Aviation (below: Peach, Representative Director and CEO: Takeaki Mori) will start sales of air tickets for the 2023 summer schedule. The applicable period is from March 26 to October 28, 2023.

The routes and fares for the 2023 summer schedule period, which will be on sale starting today, are shown in the table below. Tickets for other routes will go on sale as soon as they are ready. Tickets can be purchased via the Peach Website (www.flypeach.com) and at the Contact Center.

This year, from April to September, there were 29,339 domestic flights, twice as many as the same period last year, and approximately 3,700,000 passengers, more than twice as many as last year. Furthermore, international routes gradually resumed starting in August, and we will launch our first medium haul flight from Osaka (Kansai) to Bangkok (Suvarnabhumi) on December 27. With the demand for domestic travel by inbound passengers expected to increase going forward, we have decided to launch early sales of eight domestic routes, including the highly demanded Sapporo and Okinawa routes.

We encourage you to use Peach to make early travel plans for the warmer weather.

Peach will strive to contribute to the revitalization of regional economies as a public-transport carrier connecting various regions in Japan, while continuing to implement strict COVID-19 preventive measures, and creating new traveling styles together with our passengers.
