

Peach Performance for FY 2017 Obon Period

Osaka 21 Aug, 2017 - Peach Aviation Limited ("Peach"; Representative Director and CEO: Shinichi Inoue) today released its performance for the Obon period (August 10-20).

It is during this obon period that the total number of passengers exceeded 20 million since the opening of services in 2012.

3) Topics

While the total number of seats offered on domestic and international routes combined were 104.7% against a year earlier, the number of passengers were 105.4%, showing steady overall performance. Many passengers flew Peach during the period and particularly good performance was seen on routes to and from Sendai as well as Kyushu on the domestic front. Taipei and Shanghai on international routes.

Also notable is that on August 20 during the obon period on a flight between Hong Kong and Kansai (MM64), the total number of passengers exceeded 20 million since the opening of services in March 2012.

Peak days for domestic routes were August 11 for outbound and August 20 for incoming flights and August 15 for outbound and August 19 for inbound international flights.

Peach began its services in March 2012 with Kansai Airport as its hub. It established Naha Airport as a secondary hub in July 2014 and began servicing Haneda Airport in August 2015. More than 13,000 passengers currently fly Peach each day as it operates more than 90 daily flights, servicing 12 domestic and 13 international routes with its 19 aircraft. Peach is planning to set up a hub at Sendai Airport in September 2017 and at Shin-Chitose Airport in FY 2018.
