

Peach Announces Status of Reservations for 2017 Golden Week Vacation Period

Osaka 21 April, 2017 - Peach Aviation Limited (“Peach”; Representative Director and CEO: Shinichi Inoue) today announced the status of reservations for the 2017 Golden Week period (April 28- May 7).

3) Overview

<Domestic Routes>

Peak period: April 29 for outbound, May 2 for inbound flights

Reservations for flights bound for the Okinawa area have been particularly strong, with some flights already almost fully booked.

<International Routes>

Peak period: May 3 for outbound, May 5 for inbound

Reservations for flights bound for Taiwan and South Korea have been particularly strong. Extra flights are also planned to be operated between Osaka (Kansai) and Seoul (Incheon; one round-trip daily) on May 3 and May 6.

Seats may still be available on some flights, depending on the date. Reservations may be made on the Peach website at www.flypeach.com. Seat availability may also be checked on the Peach website, where information is updated daily.

About Peach (www.flypeach.com)

Peach began its operations out of its Kansai Airport hub in March 2012. It opened a secondary hub at Naha Airport in July 2014 and began servicing Haneda Airport in August 2015. Peach currently operates its fleet of 18 aircraft and services more than 90 flights each day on 12 domestic routes and 13 international routes, serving more than 13,000 passengers daily. Peach is planning to set up a hub at Sendai Airport in FY 2017 as well as Shin-Chitose Airport in FY 2018.
