

Partial Amendment to the Rules of Use of Peach Points

- **New rules will be applied for issuance after October 1, 2018**
- **Preventing transfer or resale to a third party**

Peach Aviation Limited (“Peach”; Representative Director and CEO: Shinichi Inoue) has announced that it will partially change the rules of use of Peach Points. The new rules will be applied to issuance from October 1, 2018 (Monday).

Peach Points are points that you can use for making full or partial payment of Peach's fares and fees, as well as its accompanying taxes and fees.

Although at present time, the Peach Points can be used as long as the Peach Point holder is the user (person making reservation) even if he or she is not included in the passenger list, based on the new rule coming into effect on October 1, it is necessary that the Peach Point holder's name is included in the passengers' list.

These changes in the rules of use of Peach Points have been made in response to confirmed cases of violations in the rules of use of Peach Points where, since last year, points were purchased through illegal credit card use and made available on auction websites, allowing third parties other than the holder to try and use the points, and the changes in rules try to prevent transfer and resale of Peach Points to third parties, and prevent their inappropriate uses.

[Details on the changes in the rules of use of Peach Points]

<Current rules>

Period of applicability: Until the issuance made on September 30, 2018 (Sunday)

Amended parts: Peach Points can be used as long as the user (person making reservation) is the holder, even if his or her name is not included in the passenger list

<New rules>

Period of applicability: From the issuance made on October 1, 2018 (Monday)

Amended parts: **The name of the Peach Point holder must be included in the passenger list**
