<Domestic Routes>

The peak period for Osaka (Kansai) departures are between August 10 - August 14, and August 15 and August 18 for Osaka (Kansai) arrival.

<International Routes>

The peak period for Osaka (Kansai) departures are between August 10 - August 12, and August 18 - August 19 for Osaka (Kansai) arrival.

Most flights during peak periods are near full capacity.

With the slogan of "Making air travel in Asia closer and more fun," Peach aims to expand networks in order to become the new bridge between Japan and other Asian countries while revitalizing human interaction and culture in the Asian region.
