Total Number of Peach Passengers Hits 5 Million Only 26 months since the start of services in March 2012

Peach Aviation Limited (Peach; Representative Director & CEO: Shinichi Inoue) announced today that it had welcomed its five millionth passenger aboard its aircraft.

Peach began its services with three aircraft flying on two routes, Osaka (Kansai)–Sapporo (Shin-Chitose) and the Fukuoka route on March 1, 2012. It had marked its first million passengers in November 2012 and three million in September 2013. Peach currently operates twelve aircraft, which fly a total of sixteen routes, ten domestic and six international.

In marking breaking past the five million number, Peach CEO Shinichi Inoue said: "I would like to thank from the bottom of my heart the five million passengers who have chosen to fly Peach during such a short period since our launch in March 2012. It is thanks to the support that we have received from so many people that Peach is able to commemorate this day. We will further continue to offer journeys in the skies aboard our safe, casual "flying trains"."

Peach will open a new route between Okinawa (Naha) and Fukuoka on July 19. With Naha Airport positioned as a hub after Kansai International Airport, Peach will continue to boost its flight services between domestic and international destinations.
