Operation of MM252, April 28, 2014

At around 11:47am on April 28, 2014, MM252 (from Ishigaki Airport to Naha Airport) flied below normal approach letdown route during final approach for landing to Naha Airport.

Peach Aviation Limited (Peach) extends its sincere apologies for any inconvenience and anxiety caused to customers onboard and parties concerned.

Ministry of Land, Infrastructure, Transport and Tourism (MLIT) has judged this case as a serious incident, and Japan Transport Safety Board (JTSB) will investigate detail of cause.

Peach will fully cooperate with investivation by JTSB and take necessary measures for preventing similar cases.
