3) Topics

Throughout the period, many customers both the domestic and international routes offered by Peach.

By route, for domestic routes the Osaka (Kansai) – Sendai and Kagoshima routes were steady as usual, with particularly good performance for the routes serviced between Osaka (Kansai) and Sapporo (Shin-Chitose), Fukuoka, and Tokyo (Narita). Performance had also been steady for international routes such as those serviced between Osaka (Kansai) and Seoul (Incheon) and Osaka (Kansai) and Busan, as well as the Tokyo (Haneda) – Taipei (Taoyuan) route, which opened on August 8 (Sat).

By date, a seat occupancy rate of 97.3% had been posted for domestic flights bound for Osaka (Kansai) on August 16 (Sun) and a 97.7% seat occupancy rate observed for international flights departing from Osaka (Kansai) on August 9 (Sun), with most flights sold out or almost sold out.
